Built in 1880 by Dublin Corporation Weights and Measures Offices, this emblematic building was and still is a reference point in the history of Dublin.

With its natural slate roof and characteristic red brick, this building has witnessed not only many changes in Ireland's capital but also the very beginning of our wine journey.

While this representative building was in the hands of the U.K. wine merchant company Berry Bros & Rudd, back in 1998, the wine shop was run and managed by Peter Foley.

But the man himself always wanted to follow his dream and after many years of experience in the wine business he decided to take a step forward and created his own wine merchant company in 2004, The Corkscrew. Since that exact year, our small little store on 4 Chatham Street, the biggest little wine shop in Dublin, has been, in one way or another, a small protagonist in special moments of our lives.

It only took us 19 years to come back to 4 Harry Street, the place where the dream took shape. Now in a larger format, with a full spirit range, our own private cellar and the same love for high quality beverages.

And now Peter's son Paul Foley keeps the family tradition beside his wife Fiona, which could be a matter of destiny as Fiona means wine in Gaelic (Fíon = wine & Gloine fíona = glass of wine)
